FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN, ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, AND ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING

Seminole County Community Services Department will be hosting virtual public meetings to solicit input on the County's 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan, 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan, and Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. The Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan serve as applications to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds.

The County is also taking meaningful actions to combat housing discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, familial status, national origin, disability. The Analysis of Impediments examines barriers to fair housing and identifies priorities and goals to mitigate fair housing issues as required under the federal Fair Housing Act.

During the public meetings, County staff will obtain input from citizens, non-profit agencies, neighborhood associations, residents of public and assisted housing, stakeholders, advocates, health care providers, realtors, lenders, educators and other interested parties on housing, homeless, community development, economic development, and fair housing needs.

The County encourages participation of all its residents especially the involvement of very low-income residents, minorities, non-English speaking persons and persons with mobility, visual or hearing impairments.
