Seminole County receives annual Federal grants through three programs administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These programs include the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program, & the Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) Program. Listed below is the estimated funding available from HUD for the 2016-2017 Program Year, beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017.

CDBG	\$1,409,097
HOME	\$480,897
ESG	\$123,876
Total:	\$2,013,870

These programs fund a wide variety of housing and community development activities for the benefit of lower income persons and neighborhoods throughout Seminole County. The County is in the process selecting the projects and activities to meet the anticipated needs identified in the Five-Year 2015-2020 Consolidate Plan.

Seminole County has selected an Application Review Team to evaluate and score the proposals received for the 2016-2017 Program Year. On Thursday, May 5th from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. all agencies that submitted complete proposals will have the opportunity to make a presentation to the Application Review Team. Then the Application Review Team will score the applications and make a recommendation for funding.
