# Agriculture in Florida

**Agriculture is the second largest industry in Florida next to tourism. There is \$148 billion in direct industry output from agriculture in the state.**

Florida is ranked second in the US for value of vegetable production. Florida's agricultural and natural resource industries cover about 2/3 of the state's land area. This industry is critical to our water supply, air quality, climate, wildlife, and outdoor recreation.

**#1** Florida is first in production value for oranges, fresh market tomatoes, watermelons, grapefruit, sugarcane, fresh market snap beans, and fresh market cucumbers.

Florida is second in the production value of greenhouse and nursery products, bell peppers, strawberries, fresh market sweet corn, spring potatoes, peanuts, tangerines, and avocados.



Specialty crops need specialty farmers! Yet less than ¼ of 1% of Florida's population works in farming, and of those that do, their average age is 59.

- Participate in a CSA program
- Shop for in season produce at a farmers market
- Grow your own in your yard or community garden
- Start farm-to-school Gardens
