

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT 2015-2019 FIVE-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN PROPOSED USE OF FUNDS FOR THE 2018-2019 ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA

Seminole County is the recipient of federal funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These grant funds include the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program, and the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program, which fund housing and community development activities for the benefit of low-moderate income persons throughout Seminole County. An action plan for the use of these funds is required to be submitted to HUD on or before August 15, 2018.

A draft of the 2018-2019 One-Year Action Plan will be available for review and comment for a 30 day period to obtain citizen comments prior to being presented for Board of County Commissioners approval.
