Pasture Reminders from the
CFLAG Calendar

July

- Apply nitrogen to warm season pasture if needed
- Check for army worms and mole crickets

August

- Cut corn silage
- Cut hay
- Apply lime for fall and winter crops
- Check for army worms, spittlebugs and mole crickets

September

- Cut hay
- Heavily graze pastures to be interplanted to cool season pastures
- Check mineral feeder
- Review winter feed supply and feeding plans so that needed adjustments can be made before supplies tighten and prices rise
