#### Class III Cadet (Minimum Age 18)

- Complete Cadet II requirements
- Complete fire department activity and testing requirements

### Requirements:

- Age 14 up to 21
- Maintain academic requirements of C or 3.0 if dual enrolled
- Complete application
- Standard of Conduct agreement
- Background check
- Medical waiver
- Drug screening
- Attend weekly meetings and monthly training drill
- Monthly membership fees - \$5.00
