## **ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**



In 2015, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) conducted an off-cycle inspection of the Southeast Regional (SER) water treatment plant. Jill Farris of the FDEP Compliance Assurance Program inspected the water plant in late May, finding the facility to such a high standard that she requested use of Seminole County's SER to train FDEP staff on Advanced Sanitary Survey inspections.

Scott Rankin, Chief Water Treatment
Plant Operator for the SER facility, led
approximately 20 FDEP employees through
the facility, detailing the advance water
treatment operations, preventative safety
controls, electronic record keeping, and
sophisticated compliance monitoring
through remote and on-site systems.

Seminole County's SER facility is the largest ozone (a chlorine alternative) and granular activated carbon (a filtration process used to remove chemicals with objectionable odors and tastes) treatment facility in the state of Florida.
