OverDrive Media Console*

Checkout and Download:

1. **Open** the *internet*.
 2. **Open** <http://semcofl.lib.overdrive.com>
 3. **Click** *Sign In*.
 4. **Type** your **14 digit library card number**.
 5. **Click** *Sign in*.
 6. Search or browse for a title available in “WMA”* or “MP3” format and **click** *Borrow*.
 7. If more than one format is available for download choose the format you wish to download then **click** *Confirm and Download*. If not, then just **click** *download*.
 8. The title should automatically start downloading to OverDrive Media Console*.
 - i. Audiobooks download in parts. You can choose to download the book in parts or all at once. Follow the prompts to complete download.
 - ii. To transfer from your computer to a mobile device, plug in your device to the computer via USB. **Select** *transfer*. Follow the prompts to complete transfer.
- *Apple iPods require audiobooks to be exported into iTunes before transfer via USB.

Early Return*:

1. **Open** *OverDrive Media Console* and **click** the title you wish to return.
2. **Click** *(X) Delete*.
3. **Click** *Return then Delete*.

*WMA titles cannot download onto Apple devices using MACs. To transfer WMAs to apple devices, download title to OverDrive Media Console using a PC then export the audiobook to iTunes. Once the audiobook is in iTunes, it can be transferred to any Apple device via USB.

*When downloading WMA audiobooks, you may be required to complete a Windows Media Player Security Upgrade. This can be found in the Menu bar under “Tools”.

*WMA audiobooks cannot be returned early and will return at the end of the lending period.
