

Fire Works Display Permit Requirements

The following required documentation shall be submitted to obtain a permit for a Fireworks Display.

1. Complete a Seminole County Commercial Permit Application.

2. Provide copy of legal description of the property. This may be obtained from the Seminole County Property Appraisers website. <http://www.scpafl.org/RealPropertySearch>
3. Complete a Seminole County Noise Exemption Permit.

The Temporary Use Permit is submitted to Seminole County Growth Management.

4. Provide a Letter of Permission from property owner allowing the display on the property.
5. Provide a copy of the ATF License/Permit (18 U.S.C. Chapter 40, Explosives).
6. Provide a copy of the ATF Letter of Clearance for employees.
7. Provide the following information as required by NFPA 1123, Code for Fireworks Display.

- B. Evidence of financial responsibility by the sponsor of the event or festival and by the operator of the event. This could take the form of an insurance certificate or other document attesting to coverage or responsibility.

- C. The date and time of day at which the outdoor fireworks display is to be held, with a proposed rain/wind date and time in the event the display is postponed.

- Date/Time

D. The exact location planned for the outdoor fireworks display.

E. Confirmation of the license of the operator and the number of assistants who are to be present.

F. The approximate number and kinds of fireworks to be discharged.

List provided

G. The manner and place of storage of such fireworks prior to delivery to the outdoor fireworks display site.

H. A site plan of the grounds on which the outdoor fireworks display is to be held, showing the following:

- a) the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged,
- b) the location of all buildings and, highways,
- c) the lines behind which the audience is to be restrained,
- d) the location of other possible overhead obstructions.

Note:

- *Additional information for pyrotechnic effects used indoors or outdoors with a proximate audience as per NFPA 1126 will be required.*
- *ATF rules and regulations may affect the permit application.*
- *All plans shall be submitted NO LESS than 10 business days before the demonstration.*
- *If the Division of Forestry has a fire band in effect, NO permit will be issued. If a ban is issued after the permit, the permit will be canceled.*
