FINDING OF FACT

The Seminole County E9-1-1 Variance Committee reviewed the applicant's request to vary from Seminole County Ordinance 2000-22, as defined in Sec 90

- Seminole County Ordinance 2000-22 states 'At time of plan review for all new construction the name by which the development shall be legally known shall be submitted for review and approval'. The Seminole County Development Review Committee approved the project as Chase Groves Villas.
- The proposed name The Villas at Chase Groves is unique and would not create a duplicate complex name.


Based on these findings, the Committee recommends approval of the request for variance. The name The Villas at Chase Groves shall be the only complex name posted on the property.
