

**Wekiva Green-Churchill Drive Road Improvement MSBU
June 20, 2014 Update
Project Status**

- On-site geotechnical testing was completed June 10, 2014.
- Laboratory tests are now being conducted and data is being amassed. Estimated completion is June 27.
- When data gathering and organizing is completed, remedial alternatives will be evaluated in regard to drainage and construction options.

Upcoming Construction Guidelines

- Maintaining access to homes will be a top priority.
- Every effort will be taken to minimize disruption during construction. Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) through the work zone will enable vehicles to safely traverse the construction zone while maintaining reasonable access to local residences, as well as protecting those working on the roads.
- Construction crews will be required to work within public rights-of-way and easements and to protect or restore driveways, sod, and fixtures within the public right-of-way to their pre-construction conditions.
- Temporary silt fences will be used to prevent sediment and debris from getting on private property.
- Frequent inspections will be conducted to ensure a clean, safe working area.
