



RULES, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

1. Entry: To enter, access the website: <http://tinyurl.com/yourparkyourstory> and upload your video under the "Upload My Video" section. When uploading, please include your name and park/trail/natural land area where you filmed your video. If under 18 years old, please submit the "2014 Seminole County Leisure Services Department Hold Harmless Agreement" found on the website listed above in your video submission. Once all is submitted, the *Your Park Your Story Video Challenge* Committee (made up of Seminole County Parks and Recreation staff), will review your video.

The video must meet the following guidelines:

- (1) Video must be no longer than two (2) minutes in length.
- (2) Video must be shot at a Seminole County park, trail, or natural lands location. A list of these entities can be found on the website above.
- (3) Video must be relevant to subject of contest and must abide by general Park Rules, which can be found on the website listed above.

If video meets the guidelines above, it will be uploaded by the *Your Park Your Story Video Challenge* Committee to the Seminole County YouTube site. You will then be notified via email that your entry has been approved and uploaded. Only one (1) video per one (1) contestant may be eligible for the monthly contest for the given calendar month.

2. Contest Details: The *Your Park Your Story Video Challenge* contest will run as follows: Contest runs from the first (1st) day of each month to the last day of each month or unless noted otherwise. Participants are highly encouraged to submit their entry at the beginning of the month to have a better chance to win. Once your video is on the YouTube site, the contestant is encouraged to promote their own video to friends, family, coworkers, etc. to "like" their video on the YouTube site by pressing the "Like" button located on their video's page. The video with the most "likes" at the end of the given calendar month will be the winner of that given calendar month and will win our prize offered for that month (prize information can be found on the website listed above).

The winning video of that given month will be featured on the *Your Park Your Story* website and be enrolled as a contestant in our "Quarterly Contest". The winning monthly videos over a three (3) month span (for instance: January, February, and March monthly winners) will compete against one another and be judged by the *Your Park Your Story Video Challenge* Committee. The winning video chosen by the committee will be the winner of the "Quarterly Contest" and will receive the "Quarterly Contest" prize.

All contestants of non-winning monthly videos may choose one (1) of the following options: (1) current monthly video may remain on the Youtube site and will be entered into the following month's contest. PLEASE NOTE: only the current month's amount of "likes" will be judged for the monthly contest. All

previously accumulated likes on the video will not be counted towards the current month's total. (2) Participant may upload a new video for the new contest month. PLEASE NOTE: only the current month's video will be judged and any likes accumulated on a previous video will not be considered for the monthly contest.

3. Eligibility: This contest is only open to residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia. Contest is open to all ages. However, any person under 18 years old at time of video entry must complete and submit the "2014 Seminole County Leisure Services Department Hold Harmless Agreement" found on the website listed above. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the contest. Employees and agents of Seminole County and their respective affiliates, officers, distributors, agencies, and prize suppliers, and their immediate family members and persons residing in the same household of such employees are not eligible to enter or win.

4. Winners: Winners will be notified by e-mail or phone. If any prize notification is returned as undeliverable, or if winner does not respond to notification within ten (10) days of the date of notification, prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner may be selected.

5. General: Once submitted, entries become the exclusive property of Seminole County. All entries approved by the *Your Park Your Story* Video Challenge Committee and that have been posted to the Seminole County YouTube site may also be used on other social media sites such as, but not limited to: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn, Myspace, Snapchat, etc. Video may also be used for any print or digital advertising owned by Seminole County. Certain contests and sweepstakes are subject to applicable federal, state and local laws. Entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the judges, which are final and binding in all respects. By entering this contest, entrants expressly acknowledge that these Official Rules have been drafted in the English language, and that any translation prepared for any reason will be of no legal effect and the English version of these Official Rules shall govern any dispute. By participating, contestant releases Seminole County and their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries and agencies and their directors, officers, employees and agents from any and all liability for any injury, death, loss, tax liability or damage of any kind arising from contestant's participation in this contest, or resulting from entrant's acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prize. Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of the prize constitutes and signifies winner's consent that Seminole County, and/or its agents may use winner's entry, name, prize information, and/or likeness for promotional purposes in any media now existing or hereinafter devised, without additional compensation. Subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations. Seminole County reserves the right to: (i) disqualify from this or any contest, now or in the future, any person it finds, in its sole discretion, has intentionally violated these Official Rules, tampered with the entry process, the operation of the contest or Website, or any other aspect of this contest; and (ii) cancel or suspend the contest in its entirety should tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or other causes beyond Sponsor's control corrupt the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper play of the contest.
