## RULES & SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

The Storyshare competition is a journalism challenge inspired by StoryCorps (<http://storycorps.org>), though it is not affiliated with StoryCorps. Check out their website for interview examples and ideas!

**CHALLENGE: INTERVIEW SOMEONE ABOUT SOMETHING MEMORABLE OR MEANINGFUL THAT IS PART OF THAT PERSON'S STORY.**

### RULES

- The competition is open to teens, ages 13+.
- Entries may be video or audio files.
- Entries should be 3-5 minutes in length.
- Editing the interview before submission is encouraged. Storycorps interviewers typically spend 40 minutes on an interview, which is edited down to highlight a meaningful story!
- Interviews **MUST** be conducted by the teen submitting the entry.
- Entries **MUST** be accompanied by a submission form, including the signature of the person who was interviewed.

### SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

- Complete a submission form, which also requires the signature of the person who was interviewed.
- A copy of the submission form can be downloaded from the Teens section of <http://seminolelibrary.org> or picked up at your local library.
- You must scan and e-mail your submission form to [teenstoryshare@gmail.com](mailto:teenstoryshare@gmail.com), or drop it off in-person at the library since it requires a signature.
- E-mail the finished video or audio file entry to [teenstoryshare@gmail.com](mailto:teenstoryshare@gmail.com), or "share" the file with that e-mail address via Google Drive.
- A librarian will e-mail you back to confirm your submission was received.
- If you would prefer to come to the library and submit your video or audio file from a CD or flash drive, the library can accommodate you. Ask to speak to your branch's teen librarian.
- **THE DEADLINE FOR ALL ENTRIES AND SUBMISSION FORMS IS THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12<sup>TH</sup>, 11:59 P.M.**
