Event Descriptions

Bedtime Movies (all ages)— Bring your own blanket and snacks and join us for a fun family movie night! FREE. No registration required.

Summer Chess (1 hour program for youth, age 5-14+) — Learn to play chess from an expert, and practice your strategic skills.

Lego Club (1 hour program for children ages 5-12) – Create, construct, and have fun! Building weekly at a library near you!

Library Explorers: Summer Science Edition (45 minute program for ages 5+) – Have a blast with science activities! Plus storytelling, crafts, & more.

Little Dippers Station (drop-in program for ages 0-4 with caregiver) While the big kids are in Library Explorers (designed especially for children ages 5 & up), join us at Little Dippers Activity Station! The special activities featured at this station practice early learning, literacy, and motor skills. Activities will be in the Sensory Lab.

Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult) – Join us for the

nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger plays, sing, move with scarves, and shake bells.

Preschool Storytime (30 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult) – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.

READing Paws (15 minute time slots for children reading independently) – Children can sign up to practice reading aloud to a therapy dog. READing Paws helps young readers gain confidence and practice fluency!

Space is limited. REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

Safe Space: Teen Writing Group (Ages 13-18): 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month. Every idea is a good idea. Learn, grow, and create with our writing group! Share your work and participate in creative workshops. **Free. For Teens 13+. No Registration Required.**

Sensory Lab (2 hour drop-in open lab time, children of all ages and their families are welcome) – Activity room featuring fun, hands-on activities that use sight, sound, and touch to promote independent exploration, creativity, and literacy.

Sensory Storytime (45 minute program, children of all ages and their families are welcome) – These programs are relaxed and interactive, designed to increase your child's comfort level with the library environment.

Soundsational Storytime (30 minute program geared toward ages 3-7 with adult) – Storytime fun for the entire family - books, puppets, crafts, and plenty of MUSIC!

Teen Cosplay Workshop: Armor Building (Ages 13-18): Start work on your epic costume for Fan Fest @ the Library! Pre-registration and a signed permission slip are required. Supplies are provided. Call or stop by the library to register.

Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult) – Stories, songs, puppets and finger plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers.

Tween 3D Printing and Modeling (1 hour program, ages 8-12) —Learn to use TinkerCAD to build a 3D model, which can later be printed on the Library's 3D printer! Two identical sessions are being offered per branch.
