

Summary

This dataset serves to create a readily usable existing land use layer based on the Property Appraisers DOR-4 Code values. The data is used as a planning tool in conjunction with the County's Comprehensive Plan. The advantage having a predetermined category assignment is standardization of land use assignment enabling a quick response to general planning questions.

Description

The data is derived from grouping Property Appraiser Office DOR-4 codes into 21 predetermined existing land use categories. These 21 existing land use categories consist of state mandated themes in accordance with 9J-5 FAC dealing with comprehensive planning. Furthermore, three additional categories created by the Planning Division and were derived separate from the DOR 4 code groupings – transportation, managed environmental lands, and dedicated area.
