**RESERVATIONS:** To reserve this campsite call (407) 665- 2180

**CAMPING TIPS:**

Acquire a permit and begin hike in at least 2 hours prior to sunset.

Have copy of permit at all times while camping.

Bring fresh drinking water, insect repellent and cell phone.

All plants and animals are protected.

Do not feed any wildlife. Secure food out of reach.

Pets are allowed but must be leashed at all times.

Fires are restricted to the fire ring and to be extinguished prior to departure.

Only dead wood on the ground may be collected and used for fire wood.

Emergency response is very limited at this site, plan accordingly.

Please keep the camp site clean and pack out all trash.

Small shallow holes can be dug and filled to dispose of personal waste.

**Limitation of Liability** – Seminole County does not, by providing any of its Natural Lands for outdoor recreational purposes, extend any assurance that such areas or lands are safe for any purpose. The County will attempt to post known hazardous conditions.
