





Did you know that Seminole County has an Educational Fertilizer Program?

Have a Beautiful Yard AND Help Protect Our Waterways by following these simple Tips:

Fertilize Wise: Do not apply any fertilizer containing nitrogen (N) between June 1st and September 30th. If needed, use fertilizers with potassium (K), iron (Fe), Magnesium (Mg), Manganese (Mn) and other micronutrients, often called "summer blends"

Know Slow: During the non-restricted season (Oct — May), use only fertilizers that contain 65% or more slow release nitrogen (SRN).

Phosphorus-Free: Do not use fertilizers that contain any phosphorus (P) on your lawn. Look for fertilizers that have "0" in the middle (15-0-15).

Buffer Zone: Do not apply any fertilizer within 15 feet of any waterbody or wetland.
