ACT

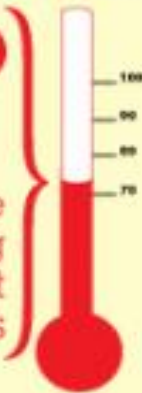
AVOID heat stroke by never leaving your child alone in the car
