NEW BUSINESS:

Brett Blackadar, Seminole County Engineering presented a Safe Routes to School application for construction of sidewalk on Wilson Road near Wilson Elementary and requested endorsement from the CTST for the application. The Team support was unanimous. In addition, he asked that any walking routes that were in need of a sidewalk be forwarded him for review and consideration as funds become available.

Robin presented the CTST Program of Work for 2007, and requested assistance with obtaining the missing stats, specifically the number of Enforcement activities conducted in 2007. It was stressed how important it is to report all enforcement activities.

The 2008 Action Plan along with thoughts as to what our Goals for 2008 would be were discussed. Both items will be developed in detail at the February 26 meeting. The annual calendar of events was reviewed with several items added. The amended calendar will be submitted with the mailing for the January minutes. Any additions or modifications should be sent to Robin or Philip.

It was suggested, that generic Ops Plans be available to all Agencies via the CTST web page or through Robin. Robin and Lt. Kelting will coordinate and have these available by the February 26 meeting.

Philip Miller discussed the Roadway Safety Assessment Team workshop which was presented at the State CTST Coalition meeting on January 14, 2008. Philip explained the concept of a Roadway Assessment Team and suggested that we develop our own. The Team would go to various sites where it was determined that a safety related issue existed to determine what, if anything could be suggested to improve the location.
