Call to Order

2) Approval of the Agenda

4) Old Business

i) Mosquito Control Code

Horvath said that the Code has been forwarded to the County Attorney's office for support documents to be presented to the BCC.

ii) Communications between the Committee and Commissions

Peluso requested clarification of the policies regarding adulticiding. Horvath stated that the County will not be spraying within City limits. Any calls received are documented in the work orders and forwarded to the Cities for spraying as usual. The Cities will forward any spray scheduled to the County for follow up for recording in the work orders.

iii) Aerial Operations

The County will conduct aerial larviciding missions over rural areas as part of the overall program. Aerial adulticiding will be conducted as needed or in the event of an emergency.

5) New Business

i) Treatment Report

Horvath stated that the County has over 500 acres. The County has received approximately 450 calls, 200 incorporated and 250 in unincorporated areas. Areas that the County has sprayed is tracked using GPS, and will be provided to the Cities if needed.

ii) Phase-In Time Line

Horvath stated that the County is still on schedule, and has progressed faster than anticipated. Although the County is doing more in-house and doing more treatments countywide, the phase-in timeline will not be shortened. There will be no outsourcing other than the aerial spraying.

iii) Do Not Spray/Call Before Spray Lists

Horvath stated that the County is compiling a report on residents that would like to be included on a do not spray list. The County is also implementing a reverse 911 system to notify residents that are on the do not spray list.
