PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

***No registration required unless otherwise noted.** Visit SEMINOLELIBRARY.ORG, scroll to “Library Programs & Events,” and click “Learn More” for more information and to register for programs.

- **Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult)** – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and fingerplays, sing, and move.
- **Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult)** – Stories, songs, puppets and fingerplays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for adults.
- **Preschool Storytime (20 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult)** – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.
- **Library Explorers (30 - 45 minute program for ages 5+)** – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment!
- **Lego Club (60 minute program for ages 5+)** – Calling all Lego builders. Build your own Lego creation or collaborate with new friends. Legos are provided.
- **We ♥ Art (60 minute program for ages 5-12)** – Join us each month to learn about the work of a different artist. Then create your own awesome art inspired by their creative techniques!
- **Shimmy, Shake, and Dance (30 minute program for children 2-5 years old with adult)** – Join us for a fun program that will focus on moving and dancing. Adults will participate with their little ones; all movements can be modified. A repeat of this program will be offered one Saturday per month.
- **READING Paws (15 minute sessions for kids reading independently)** – Allows children who are reading independently to practice fluency by reading out loud to a trained READING Paws dog. **REGISTRATION REQUIRED.** Register for a 15-minute slot by calling or stopping by your library branch.
- **Mini Dioramas for Tweens (60 minute program for ages 8-12)** – A mini diorama will allow you to travel while staying in the comfort of your local library branch. Fill a small tin with your travel dreams!
- **DIY Ribbon Bulletin Board for Teens (60 minute program for ages 13+)** – Make your own ribbon bulletin board that’s both pretty and useful. Customize them with different fabrics and ribbons and keep all your plans and adventures organized.
- **Teen Cosplay Workshop: Working with Worbla (2 hour program for ages 13+)** – Learn how to create an epic costume in our 5-part workshop series. Attend one or all five. In this session, you will learn how to work with Worbla, a non-toxic thermoplastic used in making costume parts. All supplies will be provided. **REGISTRATION AND SIGNED PERMISSION SLIP ARE REQUIRED.** See the event flyer for information about other sessions and the end-of-summer costume party and contest.
- **Summer Chess (60 minute program for kids and teens)** – Learn to play chess from an expert. Join us weekly throughout the summer for this instructive and fun program.
- **Game Night (For the Whole Family)** – Join us for monthly Game Night! *Children must be accompanied by an adult.* Bring your own snacks and favorite board game (or use one from the library’s collection).
- **Family Movie Night (For the Whole Family)** – Join us for monthly Family Movie Night! This month, we’ll be watching *Rumble*. *Children must be accompanied by an adult.* Bring blankets and snacks.
- **Atlantic Coast Theater Presents Winnie-the-Pooh at the Library (60 minute program ages 5+)** – Join us for a charming new adaptation of A.A. Milne’s original 1926 book filled with music, audience interaction, and stories of friendship.
- **Summer Sports and Games Party (For the Whole Family)** – It’s time for the Summer Games! Join us for a variety of crafts and activities including mini-archery, pool noodle javelin throw, and ring toss. Design your own medal or create an origami bracelet. There’s something for everyone.
