Agriculture is the second largest industry in Florida next to tourism. There is \$148 billion in direct industry output from agriculture in the state.

Florida has a huge diversity of agricultural operations! Our unique climate with mild winters allows for year-round production of many incredible agricultural products. Throughout the state we have over 47,500 farms covering nearly 28% of the state's land area. Despite being a relatively urban area, Seminole County has more than 400 farms!

Not only do these farms help feed our ever-growing population, but they offer unique ecosystem services that improve our quality of life. These farms can help with water quality and air quality, provide habitat for thousands of native plants and animals, offer outdoor recreation, and more.



Florida is first in the U.S. for production of oranges, fresh market tomatoes, watermelons, grapefruit, sugarcane, fresh

market snap beans, and fresh market cucumbers.

Florida is second in the production value of greenhouse and nursery products, bell peppers, strawberries, fresh market sweet corn, spring potatoes, peanuts, tangerines, and avocados.
