Accomplish Major Components of the

Sales Tax Program

(1st and 2nd Generation)



County Revenue Projection Decreases 2nd Generation Sales Tax Over \$40 Million from Prior Projections



Increase in Right-of-Way Costs Especially State Roadways



Received Over \$20 Million in Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP) Funds

Allows Seminole County to Accomplish Major Components of the Sales Tax Program



Construction Costs have been

15 to 20 Percent Under Estimates

Programs Substantially Phasing Out After FY 08/09

- New Sidewalks
- Arterial / Collector Reconstruction
- Minor Projects (turn lanes, etc.)
- Traffic Operations
- Future Capital Improvement Program

In Future Years approximately 5 Million Annually from 2nd Generation Sales Tax Available for All of the Above Programs



OTHER PROGRAMS (Millage / Gas Tax)

Resurfacing

(25% Reduction Based on Asphalt Costs – 38 Lane Miles Reduced to 28.5 Lane Miles)

Bridge Rehabilitation (New)

(\$250,000/year)



- Dirt Road Program Complete
- State Road 46 TRIPS Match
 \$3.6 Million (1991 Sales Tax)
 Right-of-Way Only



- Funding Available for Major Projects
- Other Programs Adjusted to Revenue and Right-of-Way Cost Issues
- Some Programs Negatively Impacted

 - Bridge
