#### Summer


During the Summer, Natural Lands hosts Summer Eco Camp for children 7-12 and Biology Boot Camp for 13-15 year olds.

### Wilderness Areas and Preserves


Did you know that Natural Lands manages 9 public wild lands for you to explore? No matter where you live in the county, there is likely a wilderness area close by.
