


# DENTAL PROGRAM



The Community Assistance Office will provide Dental Assistance to income eligible Seminole County residents. The purpose of the Dental Assistance program is to provide financial assistance to adult Seminole County residents with deep cleanings, extractions, fillings, partial/full dentures, referral costs, x-rays, root canals and crowns.

To be eligible for this program, the applying household must meet the minimum criteria below:

- Household must reside in Seminole County and not within the city limits of Sanford.
- Please note that funding is not available for residents of the City of Sanford.
- If approved, the dental office used for services must be located in Seminole County but cannot be located within the city limits of Sanford.
- Funding for moderate income households has been expended. Funding remains available for low income households with the exception of households that reside within Sanford City limits.
- Household income must be at or below 80% of the current Area Median Income.
- The person applying for assistance must be at least 18 years of age or older.

In addition, the household must provide the following documents to be determined eligible:

- Valid Florida ID or valid Florida Driver's License for all adults (18yrs and older).
- Birth certificates for all minor children in the household.
- Third party verification of all household income and assets is required for this program.
- Valid Lease Agreement, Mortgage statement, or proof of homeownership.
- Homeless Customers can complete the signed Homeless Affidavit Form
- Dental referral written by a licensed Central Florida dentist within the last 6 months.
