- 1. A site plan, showing boundaries, areas to be logged, ramp area locations, and access points for the trucks.
- Show size and type of trees to be logged.
- Show a fifty (50) foot buffer of any lands that are residentially designated, zoned, used or occupied.
- Provide all applicable conditions and recommendations outlined in the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' publication titles "Silviculture Best Management Practices".
- Show any Historic trees on site plan.
Ch 2 Definition SCLDC: Historic tree: A healthy tree with a trunk caliper of twenty-four (24) inches or more.
- Location and method utilized to safeguard trees that will not be logged.
- Show silt fence, a double silt fence may be required.
2. Provide the hours of operation for logging.
3. State the duration of the logging process.
4. Outline procedures to be utilized for prevention of erosion and pollution control.
5. Outline procedures for restoration of altered terrain, including plans for reforestation.
6. How many loads of trees would be taken from the property?
7. Provide a haul route for the logging trucks. For any hauling on County roadways, a right-of-way use permit must be obtained at Public Works Engineering, 407-665-5762.
