

Black Hammock Restoration Project Public Meeting Notice

In 2012, Seminole County received a grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) to restore flow to historic floodplain areas in the Black Hammock in order to improve water quality in Lake Jesup. Seminole County is in the process of completing the final design and construction plans for the Salt Creek Restoration Project. In addition to restoring flow to historical floodplain areas along Salt Creek, the County is in the process of designing culvert replacements in the Salt Creek system within the County's right-of-way (ROW) in order to improve conveyance and reduce roadway flooding.


Please join Seminole County representatives for an open house to learn about the Salt Creek Restoration and Culvert Improvements Projects.
