This Schooling Horse Show is open to any active Florida 4-H member, between the ages of 8 - 18.

The most recent Florida State 4-H Horse Show "Official Rule Book" will apply. Rule Books are available in your local 4-H Office and will be available at the show. Walk-Trot contestants may be 8 - 18 years old but must not have cantered or loped in any judged competition.

Participants may show more than one horse, but only one will be used for high-point scoring.

Refer to specific divisions for required classes for awards.

The purpose of this show is the youth, not the horse. While youth will be receiving awards, the focus is to constructively critique their performance in order to improve their riding skills.

Age groups: Jr./Int.: 8-13 years of age, Sr.: 14-18 years of age as of September 1, 2019

Friday Arrivals (optional): Participants must arrive between 5:00 - 9:00 p.m. on February 28, 2020.

Saturday and Sunday: Registration opens at 7:00 a.m. and the show begins at 8:00 a.m.

Bit check will be done at the Show Office - Speed bits must be checked and tagged!

A current Coggins must be presented immediately upon arrival to the Show Office or Check Area.

The facility will be closed one hour after each day's classes.

There are limited hook-ups for those staying overnight on site. A fee is charged. Reserve a site by calling the Volusia County 4-H office.

If you have any questions about the requirements or procedure for any class, please refer to the 2020 (or most recent) Florida State 4-H Horse Show Official Rule Book.

For Jr./Int. and Sr. classes, the contestant's age is as of September 1, 2019. Each contestant should enter the proper class according to age of contestant, age of horse, and height of horse. Class changes will not be permitted after the registration deadline which is February 14, 2020. Walk-Trot contestants can be age 8-18 but must not have cantered or loped in any judged competition.

The show will be held on the dates scheduled barring a natural catastrophe. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors' parents or guardians to determine if they are able to compete safely. In case of inclement weather, all contestants should realize that the conditions and facilities are the best available as determined by the show management and must accept these conditions and show accordingly. Helmets must be worn by all riders while mounted on Silver Sands property. Helmets must be worn in all classes.

You MUST have, in your possession, a copy of your current negative Coggins upon entering Silver Sands Bridle Club property.
