INSTRUCTIONS AND CONDITIONS

UNDERGROUND UTILITY PERMIT

THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS GOVERNED BY AND REGULATED BY THE FOLLOWING APPLICABLE DIRECTIVES:

- Florida State Statues, Chapter 124.42
- Chapter 77-153, Laws of Florida, Protection of Gas Pipelines
- Seminole County Ordinance No. 80-35, Land Development Code
- Amendments to Ordinance 80-35. particularly Resolution of July 28, 1981 establishing fees
- Regulations for the Transportation of Natural and Other Gas by Pipelines (Parts 191 & 192)
- Title 49 of the code of Federal Regulations
- AND ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE SEMINOLE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

SECTION I General Information

To be completely filled out by applicants. All site and subdivision applications must be accompanied by a certified engineer estimate of construction costs or firm contract for construction. These estimates or contract will be subject to review for comparison with current local market prices.

It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the county's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the permittee; and the permittee will at all times, assume all risk of and indemnity, defend, and save harmless the County of Seminole from and against all loss, damage, cost or expense arising in any manner on account of the exercise of attempted exercise by said permittee of the afore-said rights and privileges.

Applicant declares that prior to filling this permit, he has ascertained the location of all existing utilities, both aerial and underground. The specific names of the agencies that have been notified must be typed or printed in the space provided, for the specific type utility.

It is expressly stipulated that this permit is a license for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in said holder.

The Construction and/or maintenance of a utility shall not interfere with the property and rights of a prior occupant.

PENALTIES

Any work that commences without the required permits available on the job site shall be immediately suspended until such time as the required permits have been acquired. A penalty fee for work commenced without a valid permit issued shall be charged in addition to the normal permit fee. Emergency work is excluded from penalty fees.
