The following is a non-verbatim transcript of the Seminole County Animal Control Board meeting held June 11, 2015 at 7:00 PM, at the Sheriff's Office/Public Safety Building, 150 Bush Boulevard, Sanford, Florida.

I. Call to Order.

Gayle Hair called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

II. Roll Call.

Roll Call was taken by the Acting Clerk. A quorum was met.

III. Minutes: March 24, 2015.

Gayle Hair called for review of the minutes. Heather Smith motioned to approve the minutes. Bryan Wilson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously and the minutes were approved.

IV. Public Commentary.

Gayle Hair announced the Board would take public commentary and called for the first speaker. There was no public speaker at this time.

Public Speaker arrived late to meeting at 7:37pm, out of order from the agenda. Gayle Hair, Vice Chairman gave permission to speak.

Nick Maas, 4872 Shoreline Cir., Sanford requested to speak to the Board regarding his recent experience with Animal Services and cats he has been feeding in the area of 17/92 and 27th Street, Sanford. Gayle Hair suggested Mr. Maas meet with Bob Hunter to look into the situation. Board requested that they be informed of the resolution at the next board meeting.

V. Old Business.

Bob Hunter discussed follow up on the Animal Control Board requested items from previous meeting included within the agenda backup.

Gayle Hair states that she appreciated the list of rescue groups that have agreements with Animal Services.

VI. New Business.

(New) Board Veterinarian Position.

At the start of New Business discussion, Bryan Wilson brought up the absence of Dr. Moja, this being the third consecutive meeting missed, suggested refilling vacant position. Ann Colby advised the Board to make a motion to vacate veterinarian position. Bryan Wilson made the motion. Theresa Dickinson seconded the motion. Motion was passed unanimously.

A. Discussion of Roles and Responsibilities of the Animal Control Board Members.

Ann Colby provided a hand out of the Seminole County Codes and Florida State Laws regarding the function of the Animal Control Board, Sec 20.05 and also explained its position on dangerous dog hearings. Gayle Hair asked if Ann Colby would explain to the new board members what to expect in a Dangerous Dog hearing. Ann Colby went over step by step what takes place in a Dangerous Dog hearing and advised the Board that before the hearing she would answer questions the Board had.

B. Animal Services Initiatives

- Bob Hunter spoke regarding Animal Services new Cisco phone system installed on 6/10/15, which keeps track of call volume,

records calls, and has new phone messages in dispatch and at the front desk.

- To increase water pressure at the shelter there was a booster pump installed. Currently bidding on gas water heater for kennel building by July (13/14 budget).
- Parking lot repaving in the customer and shelter areas by July/August (13/14 budget).
- By the end of summer will have tracking system in place on kennel cards to runs using barcodes inventory system.

C. Community Events.

- Example of working together, we transferred to Orange County Animal Services another eighteen (18) cats and four (4) puppies to place up for adoption.
- In May, Animal Services held the 5-5-5 event where all dogs and cats over 5 years old were only \$5 to adopt. Event went well was decided to be held over for another month, through 6/30/15.
- In June, Mastro Subaru presented TEARS (our non-profit partner) with a check for \$13,127.00 as part of their Share the Love Champaign where SCAS and TEARS were chosen as their Hometown Charity.
- In July, Animal Services will be running a 1776 event, where adoptable dogs and cats will be \$17.76 to adopt. Animal services will also have their Smitten for Kittens adoption event at Hollywood Houndz in Lake Mary.

D. Future Agenda Items

Bryan Wilson suggested the Board have a shelter tour. Bob Hunter will meet with his staff to get feedback on best day/time and bring back at a future Board meeting. The Board may call Denise Sims, Clerk of the Board and advise what would be the best day/time for them.

Theresa Dickinson brought up the confusion with receiving a green postcard from Pet Data in Texas, at first thought it was a scam. She suggested that the postcard needs something more visual such as a Seminole County Pet License Renewal or at least Animal Services should inform the new owner that they will be receiving a postcard for renewal from Pet Data in Texas at time of adoption.

- 1) Accepting credit cards for donations at shelter
 - Begin accepting credit card donations in-person over the counter effective 9/1/15
 - Currently working on changes to website for online cc acceptance; projected completion by 9/30/15
- 2) Water Pressure and Temperature Project
 - Project to increase water pressure in Kennel Bldg was completed through the installation of a booster pump
 - Unable to pursue hot water & valves for kennel bldg as too cost prohibitive
- 3) Pet Rescue Agreements
 - Modifications needed to help house, treat and adopt shelter animals at external sites on behalf of the County
 - Amendments to Project Paws, CFL Pug & TEARS were completed
- 4) Adoption Partnerships
 - Currently discussing adoption partner agreement with PetSmart (for Casselberry store)
 - Proposed effort would be for special event participation only; may expand later depending on staff availability
- 5) Replacement ACB Vet
 - On 8/25/15, the SC Board voted unanimously to accept the appointment of Dr. Stephen P. Wiseman, DVM
- 6) Pet Data License Renewal Post Card
 - Revised based upon comments during June ACB meeting (see attached example)
 - Increased size of SC logo on front; underlined and bold SCAS name; clarified PetData as County's license processing center; offered in-person license purchase option at shelter
- 7) Improve Shelter Visibility
 - Signed up for Google Business to increase customer use of Google reviews
 - Allow SCAS to become administrator of the Google Business web profile
- 8) Ms. Hixon & Mr. Maas (cats from 17/92 and 27th Street)
 - SCAS Management met with above stated complainants on 6/23/15, as suggested by Gayle Hair, Vice Chairman
 - Cat trap was requested by business at that location (Rockin Rhonda's), and SCAS Officer was picking up trapped cats at that customer's request
 - The parties agreed to disagree regarding the interaction between Mr. Mass and the involved SCAS Officer as well as the enforcement of the County's Ordinance by SCAS staff
 - SCAS informed complainants that the shelter only works with contracted non-profit agencies, but allowed Ms. Hixon to become foster home for 2 kittens that were removed from property
 - Mr. Maas stated that he would pursue a 501(c)(3) designation, but no contact with SCAS since meeting until Mr. Maas subsequently contacted ACB members via email addresses (received under a Public Information Request) on 8/23/15 to request individual meetings
 - SCAS Officers have since been reminded to distribute business cards to customers as requested, and to also escalate to Supervisor as needed



Seminole County Animal Services thanks you for being a responsible pet owner. This card is sent as a courtesy to remind you to renew your pet's license. By ordinance, licenses must be renewed within 30 days of the expiration of the previous license. Licensed pets are far more likely to be returned to their homes if they become lost. If your pet's rabies vaccination has expired or is about to expire, a current rabies certificate from your veterinarian is required. Note that the 1-year pet license will coincide with the coverage date on your pet's rabies certificate. If your pet has been spayed or neutered since the last license period, pay the lower fee and submit proof of spay/neuter such as a receipt for the surgery.

To license your pet online: Go to www.petdata.com to renew your pet's license. Required documents may be submitted online, by fax or by mail. A convenience fee will apply per transaction.
