PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

- **Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult)** – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger-plays, sing, and move. **Registration Required.**
- **Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult)** – Stories, songs, puppets and finger-plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers. **Registration Required.**
- **Preschool Storytime (20 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult)** – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills. **Registration Required.**
- **Library Explorers (30 - 45 minute program for ages 5+)** – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment! **Registration Required.**
- **READing Paws (20 minute time slots for children reading independently)** – Children can sign up to practice reading aloud to a therapy dog. READing Paws helps young readers gain confidence and practice fluency! **Registration Required.**
- **Summer Reading Kick-Off Party (1 ½ hour “drop-in” program for families)** – Drop in for ocean-themed activities, crafts, photo ops, and a story program. Don’t forget to sign up for Summer Reading while you’re here! No Registration Required.
- **Tweens Paint (2 hour program for Tweens ages 8-12)** – Together we will walk step-by-step through the process of painting an awesome underwater scene during this professionally led session. Painting is easy when you take it one step at a time! **Registration Required.**
- **Chess (1 hour program for youth, age 5-14+)** – Learn to play chess from an expert, and practice your strategic skills. **Registration Required.**
- **Underwater Fossil Dig**– Learn about underwater archeology and excavation by performing your own “underwater dig”, searching for sea life, shells, and other fun surprises! **Registration Required.**
- **Finding Dory Interactive Movie** – Bring your snacks and blankets for an exciting evening watching the movie and interacting with it in a variety of fun ways! **Registration Required.**
- **Indoor Story Walk featuring *How to Catch a Mermaid*** – Join us at the Central Branch library for an indoor Story Walk in the Kids’ Zone. After you read the story, ask a Librarian for a craft to create your own mermaid tail! The Story Walk/crafts will be available all week long from June 27th through July 2nd! No Registration Required.
