PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult) – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger plays, sing, move with scarves, and shake bells.

Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult) – Stories, songs, puppets and finger plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers.

Preschool Storytime (30 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult) – Join in the fun with stories, songs, props and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.

Sensory Storytime (45 minute program for children of all ages, with adult) – A relaxed and interactive special needs-friendly program, designed to increase your child's comfort level with the library environment.

Art Starts (45 minute program for ages 0-4) – Come enjoy free play with art materials after a short, early literacy skills-based storytime. For the littlest artists!

Everyday STEAM (45 minute program for ages 4-6) – Come build, code, and play! Learn about science, technology, engineering, art, and math with items you use every day.

Library Explorers (45 minute program for ages 5+) – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment!

NEW! Mighty Makers (2 hour drop-in program for ages 8-12) – Create, invent, experiment, and make something awesome. Each session involves a new creative challenge!

NEW! Improv @ the Library (2 hour program for middle & high schoolers) – Come practice improvisation skills through games. Rely on your imagination, strengthen your confidence, and grow as an actor. **Must commit to attending all 4 sessions**. Registration required; space is limited.

Chess Club (1 hour program for children ages 5 and up. Meets second Monday of each month) – Play chess with other kids! Practice your strategy and moves. Learn from each other and from teen volunteers.

Lego Club (1 hour program for children ages 5-12. Meets one Saturday each month) – Calling all Lego builders! Build your own Lego creation, or collaborate with new friends. Legos provided.

READing Paws (15 minute time slots for children reading independently) – Children can sign up to practice reading aloud to a therapy dog. READing Paws helps young readers gain confidence and practice fluency! Registration required; space is limited.

Library Telescope Night (1 hour program for all ages) – View the wonders of the night sky! Multiple telescopes will be set up to showcase the celestial sights. In the event of bad weather, a family-friendly indoor program will be held.
