ZOOM PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

- **Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult)** – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger-plays, sing, and move. Have a rattle, scarf, or something else handy for baby to shake!
- **Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult)** – Stories, songs, puppets and finger-plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers.
- **Preschool Storytime (20 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult)** – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.
- **Bedtime Stories (20 minute program, for children 18 months to age 5 with adult)** – Get ready for bed with stories, music, and activities incorporating early literacy skills.
- **Library Explorers (30 - 45 minute program for ages 5+)** – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment! Pick up your activity bags in advance from the checkout desk at any Seminole County Public Library branch.
- **Virtual “Thankful Books” (45-minute program designed for early elementary schoolers & families)** – Pick up your activity bag from the Central Branch Library (Casselberry) **before the program**. It contains the supplies you’ll need to make a paper bag Thankful Book at home. Having your own photos on hand to use is also encouraged! Program is FREE.
- **Virtual “Let’s Draw Cute Animals” (1-hour program exclusively for ages 8-12)** – You’ll be amazed by how easy it is to draw animals in this fun, cartoon-like style! We will walk through how to draw each animal step-by-step together.
