Trails Subcommittee Report:

- Mr. Brandenburg reported that they met last week. The Lake Monroe Loop design is 30 percent complete for the Seminole County portion. He gave an update on the CST missing link.
- Mr. Brandenburg advised that there are funds available to start looking at the possibility
 of a bridge or tunnel on the Seminole Wekiva Trail at State Road 436. Mark
 Brandenburg made a motion asking Richard Durr and/or Joseph Abel to request Public
 Works Engineering move forward with starting a design and ultimate construction of

- Mr. Brandenburg reported that the blueways website is still on hold since the County website is still on hold. Mr. Abel informed that the County is in the process of hiring a webmaster to manage the County website.
- Mr. Brandenburg shared that the March meeting had two guests: Jason Lampitt and
 Mitch Greenburg from the local SORBA chapter. They expressed a desire to develop a
 mountain bike skills area somewhere at the Markham Trailhead that they will fund and
 maintain. Discussion followed. Mark Brandenburg made a motion for Richard Durr
 and/or Joseph Abel to have discussions with SORBA members about the
 possibility of developing a mountain bike skills area at the Markham Trailhead.
 There was more discussion. Jeff Ebbers seconded the motion. Discussion continued.
 The motion passed unanimously.

Parks Subcommittee Report:

- Mr. Criswell informed that they met this month at Soldiers Creek Park. He then gave an
 update on the canoe concession at Wilson's Landing Park. They also discussed
 ways to get more members involved in this subcommittee.
- The members then toured Soldiers Creek Park which is about 85% complete.
- Mr. Caldwell announced that the Soldiers Creek Park Grand Opening will be May 17th and announcements should be going out soon.
