PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Bridge Club: *Free. For adults. No registration required.* Come and play bridge at the library on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of every month!

Flying Needles: *Free. For adults and teens 15+. No registration required.* Meets the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays each month from 5:00 - 7:30 PM. Flying Needles offers you a place to knit, crochet, or do other needlework. Bring your own project, share tips and techniques, and learn from each other. Meet your friends or make new ones and catch up on your "stitches."

Family Game Night: *Free. For the whole family. No registration required.* 4th Tuesday of every month from 5:30 - 7:00 PM. Card games, board games, and other fun activities the whole family can enjoy! All materials provided by the library.

Ask a reference desk employee for assistance.* An 8-session Living Healthy Workshop held on Fridays from 10:00 - noon. Each session is designed to reduce the fear of falling and increase activity levels among older adults. Participants learn to set realistic goals to increase activity, change their environment to reduce fall risk factors, and learn simple exercises to increase strength and balance.
