# Did you know that Seminole County has a NEW Fertilizer Ordinance?

**Help protect and improve our watershed by following these simple rules:**

**Fertilize Wise:** Do not apply any fertilizer containing nitrogen (N) between June 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>. If needed, use fertilizers with potassium (K), iron (Fe), Magnesium (Mg), Manganese (Mn) and other micronutrients, often called “summer blends”

**Know Slow:** During the non-restricted season (Oct – May), use only fertilizers that contain 50% or more slow release nitrogen (SRN).

**How Much:** Visit our online calculator to see how much product you should apply to YOUR yard:

**Phosphorus-Free:** Do not use fertilizers that contain any phosphorus (P) on your lawn. Look for fertilizers that have “0” in the middle (15-0-15).

**Buffer Zone:** Do not apply any fertilizer within 15 feet of any waterbody or wetland.
