

EXECUTIVE ORDER RESCINDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2024-005  
DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, imminent danger to residents and property located in Seminole County was posed by the following conditions related to the development of Hurricane Helene: heavy rain; and possible flooding in low lying areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, said conditions have the potential for causing damage to public streets and roads, public drainage systems and commercial and residential buildings and areas; and

WHEREAS, Section 252.38(3)(a)(5), Florida Statutes, provides authority for counties to declare a Local State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Section 72.4, Seminole County Code, grants the authority to declare a local state of emergency to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners; or the Vice-Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners in the event of incapacitation or unavailability of the Chairman; or in the event of the unavailability or incapacitation of both the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman, then the Commissioner who has served for the longest continual period; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 2024-005 declared a Local State of Emergency in response to the threat posed by the development of Hurricane Helene; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Executive Order No. 2024-005 can be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Section 1. Rescinding Executive Order No. 2024-005 declaring a Local State of Emergency. Executive Order No. 2024-005 is hereby rescinded in its entirety effective at ~~10:30~~ 10:30 AM/PM. ~~9-27~~ 9-27, 2024; at
