

**EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER RESCINDING EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022-017
(WHICH CALLED FOR THE EVACUATION OF MOBILE, MODULAR AND MANUFACTURED HOMES; HOMES IN
DESIGNATED FLOOD ZONES AND IN LOW-LYING AREAS; AND FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, constitutional home rule powers, Chapter 72, Seminole County Code, the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners has adopted the Seminole County revised Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2022, Executive Order 2022-016 was executed to extend the Local State of Emergency for Hurricane Ian and to declare a Local State of Emergency for Hurricane Nicole, under the provisions of Chapter 72, Seminole County Code, due to the severe weather; very high winds; heavy rain; threat of tornadoes and serious flooding caused by Hurricane Nicole; and

WHEREAS, Section 252.38(3)(a)(5), Florida Statutes, grants political subdivisions the authority to take whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the community during a state of local emergency; and

WHEREAS, Section 72.6, Seminole County Code, grants the Chief Administrator of Emergency Management the authority to direct and compel the evacuation of all or a part of the population from the stricken or threatened area within the County if the Chief Administrator deems such action necessary for the preservation of life or other emergency mitigation, response, or recovery; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Executive Order No. 2022-017 called for the Evacuation of Mobile, Modular, and Manufactured Homes; Homes in Designated Flood Zones and in Low-Lying Areas; and for Individuals with Special Needs; and

WHEREAS, the County has now determined that Emergency Executive Order No. 2022-017 can be rescinded in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, THE FOLLOWING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS ARE NECESSARY:

Section 1. Rescinding Emergency Executive Order No. 2022-017 that called for the Evacuation of Mobile, Modular and Manufactured Homes; Homes in designated Flood Zones and in Low-Lying Areas; and for Individuals with Special Needs. Emergency Executive Order No. 2022-017 is hereby rescinded in its entirety effective upon the execution of this Order.
