  - There are planned improvements to State Road 436 that include bike lanes and a tunnel at the mall Fiscal Year 22 – 23. Funding is still needed.
  - $\circ~$  East West Trail design is funded. Seeking construction funding in Fiscal Year 20 21 for a connection to Rolling Hills.

- David Martin gave updates:
  - Cross-Seminole Trail powerline feasibility study;
  - Longwood-Markham Trail is complete;
  - The Flagler Trail bridge will be complete in a month or so;
  - Need the railroad coordination final agreement regarding the missing link but can get final plans done & advertise in the beginning of July;
  - The Lake Monroe Loop plan completion is in consultant's hands waiting on them to complete;
  - $\circ~$  EE Williamson design is expected at the end of August.
