Approval of September 23, 2020 Meeting Minutes – There was not a quorum so the minutes could not be approved.

New Business:

- Trails Master Plan
 - Rick Durr gave a presentation discussing the Trails Master Plan
 - The Public Review and Comment phase of the Master Plan just ended. The results of this were given to the BCC on October 13, 2020.
 - The surveys and videos that were available online generated a good amount of traffic, giving Leisure Services multiple sources of information from the public.
 - While compiling this data, Leisure Services looked at the State of Florida and Seminole County's immediate neighbors to make sure they had the latest information to work with.
 - The GIS Map has been updated to show the different facilities utilized on our trails system.
 - Leisure Services then mapped connection opportunities.
 - The Trails Master Plan details how all of this information could be implemented, the priorities for the trails, as well as cost estimates for new projects.
 - This information will be updated and sent to the PPAC to be reviewed at the January meeting. It will then be taken back to the BCC in March.
- Rolling Hills Trails Master Plan and Website Review
 - Rick Durr gave a presentation discussing where the Rolling Hills Trail Master Plan and Website review is currently at, and how this would be implemented in the future.
 - Currently Leisure Services is looking at Phase 1, the Trail and Park Master Plan for Rolling Hills.
 - There is a detailed video of what Phase 1 will entail on YouTube. This video is about 30 minutes long.
 - Public Comment
 - The Public Survey and Public Information page generated a lot of traffic, allowing for a surplus of information and comments from the public. This information was compiled to generate what is currently being looked at for Phase 1.
 - The goal for Phase 1 was to make sure that Rolling Hills looked like a completed park, while leaving room to add and expand in the future.
 - The concerns and good comments were discussed in detail.
 - The original plan for central gathering and parking has been revised to allow for future growth and to adhere to some of the responses given by the public
