CAMPING TIPS:

- Begin hike-in at least 2 hours prior to sunset.
- Have copy of permit at all times while camping. Put copy of permit on car dashboard
- Bring fresh drinking water, insect repellent and cell phone.
- All plants and animals are protected.
- Do not feed any wildlife.
- Secure food out ofreach.
- Pets are allowed but must be leashed at all times.
- Fires are restricted to the fire ring and to be extinguished prior to departure. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected and used for fire wood.
- Emergency response is very limited at this site, plan accordingly.
- Please keep the camp site clean and <u>pack out all trash</u>.
- Small shallow holes can be dug and filled to dispose of personal waste.
