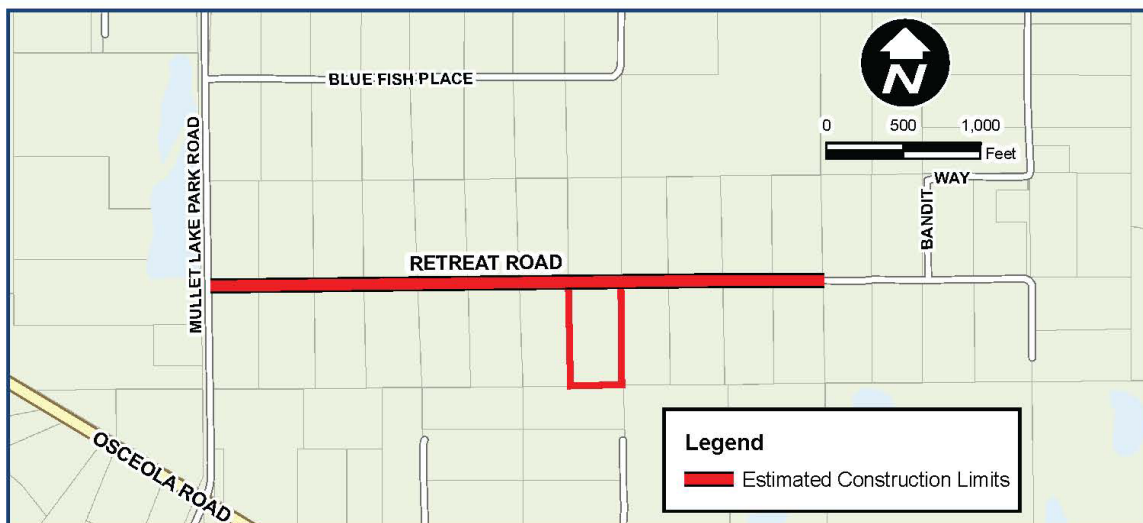

Retreat Road Drainage Improvements - Phase 1 Design

CIP No. 01907068

Overview - Seminole County would like to invite you to learn more about the status of the proposed drainage improvements along Retreat Road. The improvements include constructing a new stormwater compensation pond, regrading existing roadside ditches, raising portions of the road, and replacing select existing drainage culverts and driveways. Seminole County recently acquired the land for the stormwater compensation pond and the engineering design and permitting is ongoing. The project is being partially funded through a FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant which requires the project design and permitting be completed by November 30, 2020. Following the design and permitting, the County will advertise the project for construction and select a qualified contractor.
