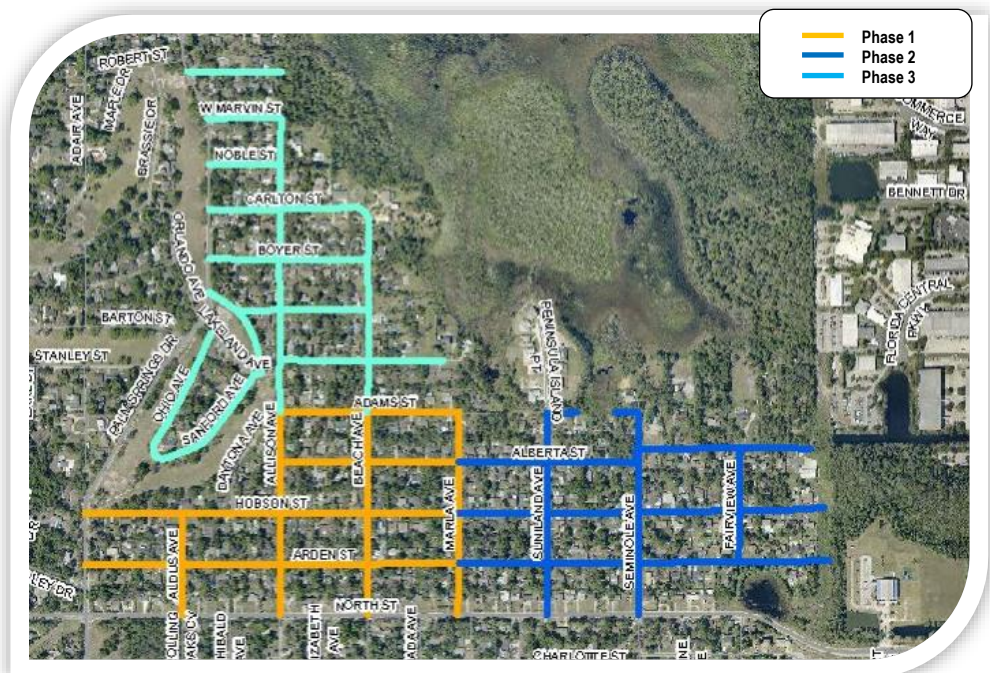

Rolling Hills Sidewalks Phase 1, 2 & 3

Overview - The Seminole County Public Works Engineering Division is in the conceptual stages of initiating a project to design and construct sidewalks along the streets in the Rolling Hills neighborhood located east of Palm Springs Drive. The intent of the project is to improve pedestrian accommodation and safety by constructing 5' wide sidewalks. As this project may involve right-of-way impacts, drainage adjustments and tree removal, we want to obtain feedback from residents before proceeding with data collection to support the design phase.
