Overview - Seminole County Public Works Engineering Division is currently designing and will construct the Wekiva Springs Road Intersection Improvements project. The project limits are from north of Fox Valley Drive to south of Sabal Palm Drive / Cutler Road. Improvements include roadway widening, drainage, traffic signal improvements, minor right-of-way impacts, landscaping impacts, and utility relocations. We anticipate road closures and detours during construction. The project is funded by the 2014 Seminole County One Cent Infrastructure Sales Tax. The goal of this project is to promote safety and improve traffic operations. The virtual public meeting will provide a status update on the project.

Virtual Public Meeting - Due to the current Covid-19 related social distance measures, a project website has been prepared to allow online feedback from all residents, tenants, and property owners. The County will hold a virtual public meeting using ZOOM platform on April 21, 2022 beginning at 6:00 PM.
