- 1) Work will be performed under and in accordance with the Seminole Education, Restoration & Volunteer (SERV) Program, along with the Public Works, Roads-Stormwater Division. The Adopt-A-Road Conditions, safety guidelines & phone numbers are attached to this permit. Permit holder must comply with at least 4 clean-ups and 1 educational activity per year.
- 2) Permit holder shall abide by all regulations relating to right-of-way utilization, safety, and all other conditions as required by the Adopt-A-Road Coordinator of Public Works for a particular adopted roadway.
- 3) All volunteers **MUST** sign in prior to an event and read the hold harmless & Indemnification Agreement attached to the sign in sheet.
- 4) Permit holder agrees that Seminole County Public Works Department may terminate this permit at any time the permit holder does not comply with the permit conditions or at any time the permit holder's work is unsafe or causes a conflict with traffic. The Seminole County Roads - Stormwater Division reserves the right to revise or discontinue this program at any time.
