

## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

**Baby Prom:** Free. Children birth to 18 months with adult. After a short storytime for the babies, enjoy social time with bubbles, music, scarves, a photo op, and a craft. Fancy outfits are optional, but encouraged!

**Bike Safety:** Free for all ages. **Registration Required.** Did you know May is National Bicycle Safety Month? On Tuesday, May 13th at 6:00 PM we will be welcoming speaker, Jackie Serrano, a certified bicycle safety specialist who has been with the Seminole County Sheriff's Office for over 12 years. She will be discussing topics, such as, understanding Florida's bicycle laws, the importance of wearing a bicycle helmet and key safety factors for riding a bicycle within the community.

**Chess Club:** Kids ages 5+. Free. Play chess with other kids! Practice your strategy and moves. Learn from each other and from teen volunteers. There will be no formal instruction.
